



# Dress Code Guidelines

## PRE-K

- Clothing: No uniform, seasonally appropriate. Modest clothing (ex: no belly shirts). Front opening sweaters/sweatshirts preferred.
- Footwear: Closed toe/closed heel shoes.

## K-12TH GRADE:

### BOYS

- BCS polo shirt OR BCS round neck sweatshirt.
- Sweater (optional): Cardigan style in gray, red, black, or navy blue.
- Black or navy blue uniform style slacks, not form fitted or tight, worn at the waist.

### GIRLS

- BCS polo OR BCS round neck sweatshirt.
- Sweater (optional): Cardigan style in gray, red, black, or navy blue.
- Black or navy blue uniform style slacks, not form fitted or tight OR Black skirt OR BCS uniform Skirt or Skort
  - \*No: Cargo, thin material, or slits
  - \*Hemlines must be no shorter than the bottom of the knee
  - \*Shorts underneath skirts and jumpers are HIGHLY encouraged!!!

### FOOTWEAR & ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE POLICIES

- Solid black or navy blue shoes. Must be completely closed in, non-marking soles, below the ankle (no boots)
- Sweater (optional): Cardigan style in gray, red, black, or navy blue.
- Solid black belt
- Solid color socks of black or navy blue. (Girls may wear white, black, navy blue or red socks or tights).
- Personal jackets are not to be worn in the Learning Center.

## CASUAL UNIFORM

- Only worn on Fridays when student earns Privilege Status or when notified by school (field trips, special events, etc.)
- Blue Jeans: Must be dark blue, loose fitted and no rips or tears
- BCS gray PE shirt
- Shoes: Black Sneakers or dress shoes
- Solid color socks of black or navy blue. (Girls may wear white, black, navy blue or red socks or tights).
